SOMETHING GRAND


a film by MATTHEW R. ANDERSON

This last April Director, Writer and Producer Matthew Anderson hiked with sound equipment and a camera over the Pyrenees, along the ancient route of the Camino de Santiago that stretches 800 km from France to north-west Spain. He followed modern-day pilgrims through mountain passes and into medieval villages to ask one question: "Why are you here?" The resulting footage and interviews are sometimes surprising, sometimes touching, and always revealing.

Dr. Matthew R. Anderson is a part-time professor in Concordia University's Department of Theological Studies and the Loyola College for Diversity and Sustainability. His main areas of expertise include Pilgrimage, the Bible and Culture Theology and Film, and Globalization and Cultural Studies.
